## 33rd Annual Nassau County Chapter Scholarship

### Rules for Application:

- The applicant must be a Facilities (Buildings and Grounds) employee working in a Nassau County School District directly under the supervision of the Director of Facilities, or the son, daughter or spouse of the employee.
- 2. The Director of Facilities must be a member in good standing in the NYSSFA (NYSSBGA) and the Nassau County Chapter as of March 1, 2021. Retirees must have attended one (1) meeting as of March 1, 2021. \*\*\*Due to COVID 19 restrictions, we will suspend the requirement that Retirees must have attended one (1) meeting as of March 1, 2021, for the 2021 Scholarship cycle\*\*\*
- The employee must be employed by a Nassau County school district in a full-time capacity for a minimum of six (6) months prior to the application date and must maintain this employment at the time of the receipt of award.
- 4. The applicant must be a high school graduate, possess an approved G.E.D., or be a graduating senior with an average grade of 75 or over, who intends to continue his/her education at a college or university.
- 5. There will be a limit of one (1) award per school district and/or household.
- Previous applicants and recipients are eligible to reapply.
- 7. To be eligible, completed applications must be postmarked **no later than** May 6, 2021 and mailed to:

- 8. At least, but not limited to, one (1) of the eight scholarships will be awarded to a <u>family member</u> of a Director. Should no Director family members apply, the reserved scholarship would then default to the general group.
- 9. All applicant essays will be judged equally based on the following:
  - 1. Quality (neatness, contents)
  - 2. Financial Need
  - 3. Community Service
  - 4. Academics (include GPA and SAT scores)
  - 5. School Achievements (clubs, activities)
  - 6. Other recognitions and awards

Prior to the end of June 2021, the members of the Nassau County School Facilities Association Scholarship Committee will determine the scholarship winners. The Committee anticipates awarding eight (8) \$2,000 scholarships. All Scholarship Committee award decisions are FINAL.

Awarded scholarship payments will be made upon submission of a bursar's tuition receipt marked "PAID IN FULL" for the 2021 Fall Semester. The committee reserves the right to request follow-up information such as transcripts to verify recipient's attendance at their school.
